Overview

Enhanced shooting performance in the field or in the competitive arena will be your experience with proven fundamentals-based instruction. My goal for each student is to develop within them an ability to consistently apply sound shotgun fundamentals while utilizing that “instinctive” shooting ability that resides “within”. This approach, joining fundamentals to instinct, will produce in you the very best shooter that you can be in whatever shooting venue you choose.

Beginning Shooters

All shooting instruction is tailored with your specific goals in mind. In general, for the beginning shooter, I start with the basics of gun safety and operation. We will also discuss shooting etiquette in the field and a Gun Club setting. During your first lesson I will determine your eye dominance and teach you proper body position and gun mount. I will also check your gun fit. Correct gun mount and fit will enable you to clearly see the target over your shotgun and ensure that you have a comfortable shooting experience. Finally we will discuss proper eye focus for shot gunning. You are now prepared to start shooting targets.

I choose to use the skeet field as my venue for shooting instruction; the targets fly along a known path which enables the student to stay focused on the task of learning to apply the fundamentals. I teach the “sustained lead” method to generate forward allowance on all targets; in



almost every shooting situation, the shotgun is moved ahead of the target along the flight path. This forward allowance is called “lead”. The sustained lead method provides the most consistent and successful approach to hitting your target. You will learn and ultimately internalize the fundamentals of

shotgun shooting as we shoot targets from each of the eight shooting stations of the skeet field. After only a short time you will experience results that you never thought possible. Joining the fundamentals to your instinct produces this success.

Shotguns

If you do not currently own a shotgun I can provide a gun that will be appropriate for you or your child. If you decide to buy a shotgun of your own, I am available to guide you through this process.



Children

Lessons for children are always focused on safety and a positive shooting experience. I prefer to work closely with the parent and child to be certain that the child is positively encouraged and ready for shooting. Together with the parent we are able to determine the best course of instruction to pursue for each individual child.

Competitive Shooters

If improving your competitive shooting performance is your goal then instruction is tailored to take you there. Successful competitive shooters execute the fundamentals consistently shot after shot. This is accomplished through a disciplined approach to shot execution and mental focus. Specific shooting issues can be diagnosed and corrected. If you prefer to improve all aspects of your competitive game then I will provide instruction that will enable you to consistently execute the fundamentals.
